

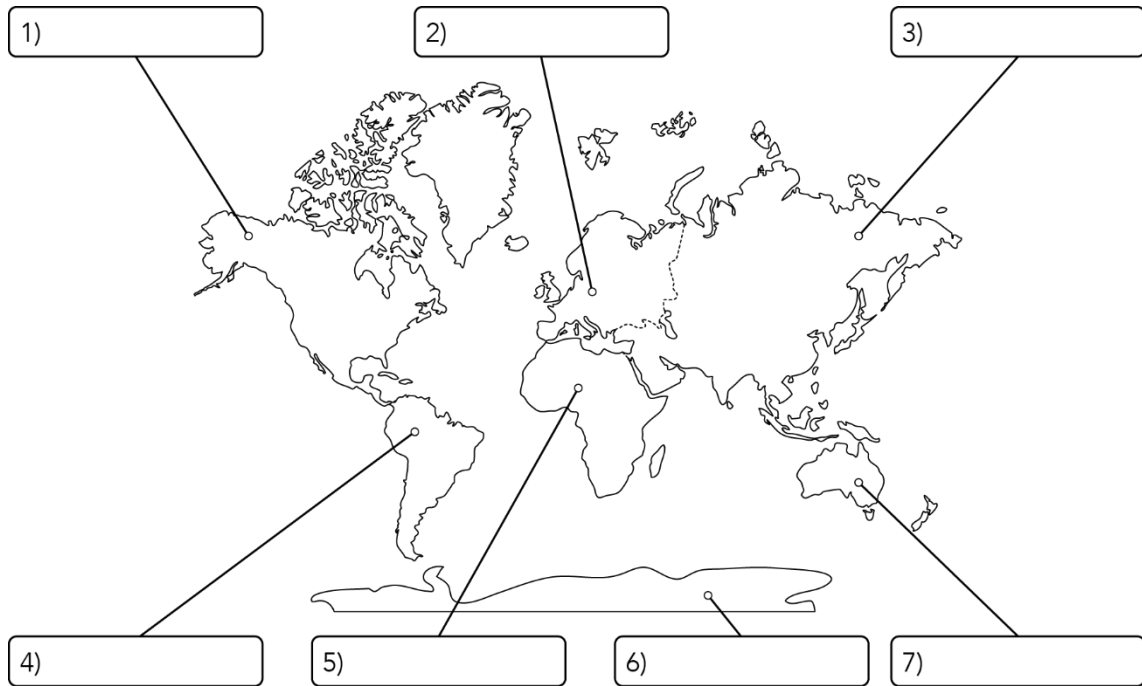
Using an atlas

Unit 5 Non-fiction for older children

An atlas is a book that contains lots of maps of the world. You can use an atlas to find villages, cities and countries. In this session, you will learn about foreign countries, continents, and flags, and see how Nepal connects to the rest of the world.



1. The world is divided into seven continents. Find them in the atlas. Can you label them on the map?



2. Find three countries that you have heard of. What do you know about these countries? Tell the group.

Find out what the students know about the world!



Which countries and famous landmarks do they know? Is there anywhere they would like to visit?



3. Can you find Nepal in the atlas? Draw it on the map!



4. Make a list of the countries that surround Nepal.

Activities 1 and 3 can be done without the worksheet. Just sketch a rough map!



5. Every country has its own flag. Use the atlas or the internet to find the flags of the countries you know. Draw your favourite flag!
